An achievement compact is a partnership agreement between the state and a school district or other institution of public education that defines key measures of student success and sets targets for achievement, as defined by the district or institution.

Under state law, each K-12 school district and education service district in the State is required to have an Achievement Compact Advisory Team, appointed by the school board. The law requires that the superintendent shall collaborate with the local employee association presidents to recommend committee members for appointment. This committee, made up of educators (administrators, teachers and education support professionals) employed in the district, is charged with collaboratively developing an implementation plan, including attainable goals aligned to available resources and student progress measures in the Compact.

All Achievement Compact Advisory Team meetings are open to the public.
