Transporting Instruments Policy

Having items not properly contained on the school bus become a safety issue. Board policy EEACC-AR states that musical instruments are not allowed on the bus.

The following instruments **cannot** be transported on the bus:

- Tuba
- Bongo
- Drums (bigger than a snare drum)

This list will be modified if needed based on the bands addition of instruments.

In an effort to assit familes, the following will be allowed, when possible.

If you have an instrument that is allowed on the bus the student must transport the instrument in this manner; the bus driver will assist the student with the instruction needed to ensure safe transport:

1. Be able to hold on the students lap in this manner:
 - a. Not be above the students chest
 - b. Not encroach the student next to you
 - c. Not stick out in the aisle
2. Be able to wedge the instrument between the seat bottom and back closest to the window.
 - a. The student must sit up against the instrument to keep it securely in place. If the student does not do this they will be asked to not bring the instrument on the bus.

If there is not a seat available to transport in this fashion, you will have to make other arrangements to get your instrument to and from school.
