



Redmond School District Board of Directors Promise Scholarship Application Guide

The Redmond School District Board of Directors will be awarding four scholarships of \$1,250 each, two recipients will be Redmond High School students and two recipients will be Ridgeview High School students. Applicants must intend to enroll at an accredited trade school, university, or community college for fall term of 2018 as a full time student. Funds will be sent to the financial aid office where the recipients will be attending.

Applications will be evaluated on the following criteria: grade point average, academic record, school and community activities, and civic engagement essay.

All application materials are due by **Friday, April 27, 2018** to the **District Office**, 145 SE Salmon DR, Redmond. Application materials must include the following:

1. A complete application, which can be typed or handwritten, but must be legible. If writing is not legible, the application may not be accepted. (Note #5, essay must be typed.)
2. Attach an activities chart listing your school, family and community activities, volunteer service, work experience, awards and certificates received.
3. Include three letters of reference, one of which must be from a teacher.
4. Include a copy of your transcript, you will need to be earning a cumulative 2.0 GPA or higher as of last posted grading period.
5. Include a one-page typed essay explaining your future goals of civic engagement. Please include your individual or collective actions designed to address public concerns, and promote the quality of your community.
